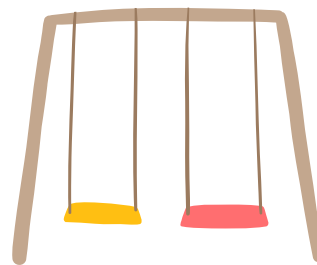
“Bring lunch money for the school trip.”
